MEDIUMS: Open to all media, including painting, drawing, photography, mixed media, video, sculpture and poetry. Original work only, no reproductions. No 'appropriated' elements unless original artist is credited in the title of your piece.

AWARDS: "Best in Show" winner will be one of seven artists who will participate in the EEAC "Winners' Show" in the Fall of 2012. First, Second, Third Place and Honorable Mentions will also be awarded.

PRESENTATION:

Professional presentation will be considered in the judging process. Work with a clean 'gallery edge' will be happily accepted unframed (canvas edge must be neatly painted or taped, no staples or tacks visible). Nicely framed artwork is also acceptable. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PROPERLY WIRED!** Please be sure neither wire nor hook shows above top edge of canvas when hung on a 1" hook.

SIZE: Maximum 30" wide x 40" high, including the frame. Sculpture Max. 72" high 24" wide. Maximum weight 40 lbs.

ENTRIES & FEES:

Open to all artists. (See reverse side for Poetry Entry Rules.) Entries limited to three works, which have not been exhibited in previous EEAC shows. **EEAC MEMBERS:** \$10.00 entry fee for each piece (3 pieces for \$25).

NON MEMBERS: \$20.00 per piece (3 for \$55). Entry fees are non-refundable. Sorry, we do not accept entries on CD. Artists may become members at time of submission. A gallery service fee of 30% will be taken upon sale.

LIABILITY:

All artwork will be handled with care; however the EEAC cannot assume any liability for loss or damage to artwork.

CALENDAR: Submissions (except poetry submissions) must be **dropped off in person** at the EEAC Gallery, 133 East Main St., Riverhead, on 2/24 -2/26. Be sure to enter required info on labels at page bottom. ***Please print clearly!*** Tape labels with ONE strip of tape to the back of your artwork **upside down on the very bottom left as you face the back of your picture.** Artists will be notified of jury decisions on or before 3/2 (If you don't hear from us by 3PM on 3/2 please call the gallery.) **Artists must pick up work not accepted 3/1 -3/5, 10AM to 4PM. No pick-ups permitted during opening reception. Work accepted in the show can now be picked up "Off-The-Wall" from 10AM to 4PM on the day the show ends, Friday, April 15 and Saturday, April 16 from 10AM-3:30 PM . Pick-up also available from porch storage April 20 -23, 10AM - 4PM. (Thereafter a \$1 per day, per item, mandatory storage fee will be assessed.) We highly encourage safe, fast, early Off-The-Wall Pick-up.**

Winter Gallery Hours: 10 AM – 4 PM Wednesday - Saturday. Please note the Gallery is closed on Sundays, Mondays & Tuesdays.

OPENING RECEPTION: will be held on **Friday, March 4 from 5-7 PM.** The public is welcome, admission free. For more info on entering the show call 631-727-0900, email Jane at gallery@eastendarts.org or check our website: www.eastendarts.org.

Poetry Submission Rules:

- **All entries must be digitally submitted** Microsoft 'Word' files/.doc (if you have the newer version of word please save as '.doc', not. '.docX'), formatted to print on letter-sized paper no longer than one page typed at 10 point Helvetica (minimum) in vertical (*portrait*, not *landscape*) format. **If it is impossible for you to send a Microsoft Word file it is permissible to send poem as email text and we will transpose to 'Word' but we cannot promise perfect formatting.**
- **Do not put your name on the poem**; Name, Title of Show, Title of Poem(s), Address, Town and Phone number go on **Poetry Entry Form**, available at the EEAC gallery or website. Title of poem is required on each (unsigned) poem.
- Email your poems to gallery@eastendarts.org. As email 'subject' put your last name and the words 'Poetry Entry'. Poems must arrive digitally no later than 2 days before the earliest drop-off date for art (for this show that date is Tuesday, Feb 22). This gives the poetry committee time to receive the poems (emailed with artists' names undisclosed from the EEAC) and thoughtfully consider all poems submitted before deciding which poems to exhibit and which to honor with First, Second and Third place.
- **Please remember, your entry fee payment of \$5 per poem for members (\$10 non-members) and filled out entry form must arrive at the gallery before your poem(s) can be considered.**
Poems that arrive by email without entry form and payment having been previously received by mail will not be accepted. Entry forms may be downloaded from our website or picked up at the gallery.
- First-place poetry winners are honored in the Winners' Show the following year.
- Sorry but we can no longer accept mailed in or dropped off poetry submissions
